We feel that these times are appropriate for the age and stage of the pupils. However, we are aware that children work at different rates/ speeds and so this is not 'a one size fits all' approach. Please let the class teacher know if the volume of homework is too great. We don't feel that we can reduce homework further as the elements of homework currently- spellings, maths facts and reading are all key components of your child's learning and form the building blocks for continued progress but we will do our best to work with parents to find what is manageable so please do bring any concerns to the class teacher.</p>

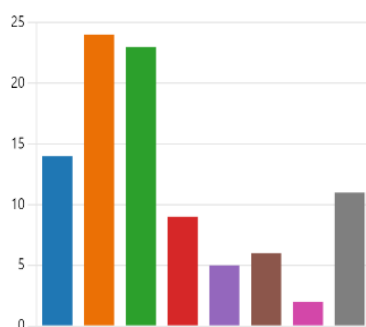
